How many hours do absolute beginners need in order to pass the driving test?

According to the **Driving Standards Agency** (DSA) most people fail their driving test because they are not ready. Those who pass their driving test have had, on average, about 45 hours of professional training, combined with 22 hours of private practice, claims the **DSA**. The **DSA** says that candidates who combine professional instruction with private practice are more successful on the test.
